- **1995** SSA Mexico began operations with the Specialized Container Terminal I at the port of Manzanillo.
- **2003** SSA Mexico increases its presence with facilities in Acapulco, Cozumel, Progreso and Veracruz.
- **2016** Tuxpan Port Terminal begins operations.
- **2017** Start-up of the Specialized Automobile Terminal in Lazaro Cardenas, Michoacan.



# MANZANILLO

## Containers
